Accepted artists are reviewed for Guild membership.

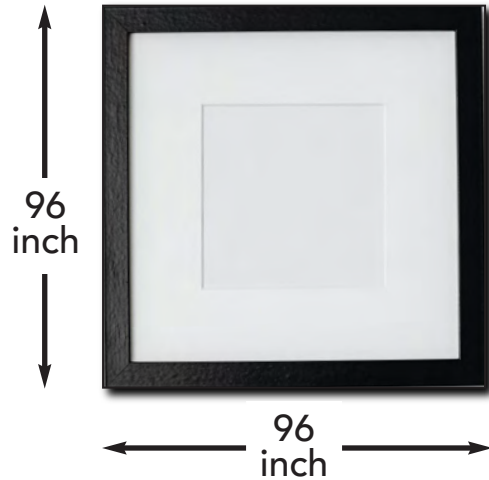
